Item #1- Accept Minutes from the November 10, 2020 Regular Meeting- Mayor

1. Update on City financials- Hamms

Councilman Hamms asked CPA Kenneth Folden to update us on financials:

Mr. Folden stated that 2019 audit has been submitted to the auditors and his firm is working on the 2020-2021 financial and doing minor cleanups. Mayor Moss asked if the Council would receive financial reports every month and Mr. Folden replied yes, he will get monthly financial to the Council. Attached is Financial reports (current thru November) for review and Mr. Folden is asking that we be very careful on spending because of the new wave of COVID-19 and we just do not know where our revenue will be. Councilperson Junkin asked out of all the department is there any departments that need to be held closely, Mr., Folden thinks that every department is ok, but we just need to watch spending. Councilperson Hamms asked about hurricane expenditure and are we in a rough position. Folden replied we have all kind of expenses, but we are counting on getting assistance from FEMA and suggested that no expenses from the Hurricane should be paid until we get money from the government office, also we have been released by the legislative auditors and can receive the grant money.

Councilperson Junkin asked about concerns about employee overtime that is not authorized and suggested that we get a handle on it so that things do not get out of control, so we can save money where we can. City Clerk replied that the She and the Mayor Moss met concerning the overtime and have come up with a solution. Mayor Moss stated that it is a scheduling issue, but the situation has been addressed.
